

**Greathouse/Shryock Traditional Elementary School
PTA Meeting Minutes
August 29 and 30, 2011**

Call to Order: PTA president, Staci Rampenthal, called the meeting to order at 6:34 p.m. in the library of Greathouse/Shryock Traditional Elementary School. There was a quorum in attendance.

Minutes: The minutes from the August 2, 2011 meeting were reviewed and will be filed as written.

Treasurer's Report: Scott Newland reported that the 2010-2011 fiscal review had been completed and all filings were found accounted for and accurate. The treasurer's report was reviewed and will be filed for audit.

President's Report: Staci Rampenthal introduced herself as the 2011-2012 PTA President. She thanked past President, Laura Mechlin, for her service and contributions to the school. Parents were encouraged to give of their time, talents and treasures by volunteering, joining a committee, and giving to the Gallop fundraiser.

Officer Reports:

Membership: Staci Rampenthal reported that the membership drive is underway. A portion of the money from PTA dues goes to fund programs at the school. The deadline for sign-ups is September 29.

Fundraising: The Gallop fundraiser goal is \$100,000 this year – that equates to \$168 per child. Parents were reminded to return SBDM ballots to the school by September 2.

Communication: Look for the September Lion's Tale on September 1.

Principal's Report: Mrs. Davis reported the school year had started off very well. Parents were reminded that notes must be sent to school if a child was going to have a transportation change. Phone calls are only for emergencies and must be received by 3:15pm. Reading and math assessments have been completed for every child. Students below the acceptable level have been identified and will be receiving letters home to attend ECE. 12 additional smart boards are needed by the end of the year to have one in each classroom. A coupon book fundraiser is underway to help fund this project.
